HARVEST FESTIVAL

We will be celebrating our Harvest Festival on the morning of Wednesday 9th October at 9:15am in St Mary's Church, Twyford. Parents are welcome to join us for this collective worship if they would like to.

PENALTY NOTICES FOR TERM-TIME ABENCE

You will have seen in the national news that from this September the Government have introduced a new penalty notice scheme for unauthorised school absences. <u>Details are included at the bottom of this this newsletter</u>. Any request for term time absence should be made via the Absence Request Form available from the school office, however please be mindful that Headteachers are not able to authorise ANY absence unless there are exceptional circumstances.

PARENT CONSULTATION MEETINGS

Earlier this week you received a ParentMail inviting you to book a meeting with your child's class teacher. The booking portal is now open and you will need to directly book a time yourself via ParentMail.

We will also be opening the school on Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th October between 3:30pm and 5:30pm for you to visit the school and view your child's work ahead of meeting with their teacher. There is no need to book an appointment for this; just come along at a time between those mentioned above. Your child's books will be in their classrooms.

FOOTBALL SQUAD TRAINING - Years 4, 5 and 6

Following the success we had when Year 5 and 6 played some football matches last year, we are setting up our very own Twyford Football Squad. If your child is in Year 4, 5 or 6 they will be able to take part in training every Tuesday lunchtime with Mr Goodwin. In order to participate, your child will need to wear shin-pads and either football boots or trainers (different to the ones they are wearing in school if in PE uniform) If your child has PE that day, they will be able to wear their PE kit. If not, they will need to bring some sports clothes to change into. During training, Mr Goodwin will work with the squad on drills, skills work and developing game strategies. Please note, that any football matches will be for Year 5 and 6 pupils only with the teams being selected from those who regularly attend training.

COLLECTION AT THE END OF THE DAY

The end of the day is a busy time in the school office so if arrangements for your child going home are changing, please let us know as soon as possible to ensure the message gets passed onto class teachers in time. If you are going to be late collecting your child at the end of the school day and have not been able to make alternative arrangements, then we will place them in after school club with NXT Level Coaching. Please note a charge for wrap around care will be made for this.

COOL MILK SCHEME

Penalty Notices for School Attendance

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following will come into force for absences that start after 19th August 2024. This is nationwide and across borders if you move school or house. Term Time Leave is only allowed in exceptional circumstances when communicated in advance with evidence provided as soon as possible to the Headteacher.

FIRST OFFENCE

The first Penalty Notice issued for Term
Time Leave of Absence or Irregular
Attendance, the amount of the fine will be
£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28
days and reduced to £80 per parent, per
child if paid with 21 days

SECOND OFFENCE

For the second Penalty Notice (within three years of the first offence) issued for Term Time Leave of Absence or Irregular Attendance, the amount of the fine will be £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days. No reduced rate will be offered

THIRD OFFENCE AND SUBSEQUENT OFFENCE

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave of Absence or Irregular Attendance, a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court. If found guilty there could be up to a maximum fine of £2,500 or a term of imprisonment not exceeding 3 months.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU
COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR
CHILD'S SCHOOL

In law only the headteacher of a school can authorise a child's absence. A pupil's attendance forms part of their official school record.

Parents do not have an automatic right to remove their child from school during term time for the purpose of a leave of absence and are strongly advised not to do so.

Headteachers are unable to authorise leave of absence during term time unless they are satisfied that there are exceptional circumstances.

The fundamental principles for defining 'exceptional' are rare, significant, unavoidable and short. 'Unavoidable' implies that an event could not reasonably be scheduled at another time.

10 sessions in 10 weeks

Penalty Notices will be considered for any 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in 10 weeks

5 consecutive days of term time absence can trigger a Penalty Notice.

Do not forget that Penalty Notices are issued Per Parent. Per Child. i.e. Two siblings absent would result in each parent receiving 2 fines. This could amount to £640


