

EYFS - Understanding the World

Teaching technology in the Early Years doesn't have to involve computer work at all. Instead an approach that is centred around play-based, unplugged (no computer) activities that focus on building children's listening skills, curiosity and creativity and problem solving means that they develop a familiarity with equipment and vocabulary. Technology in the Early Years can mean taking a photograph with a camera or tablet, playing games on the interactive whiteboard, exploring an old keyboard/typewriter or other mechanical toys, using 'cause and effect' toys, watching a video clip or listening to music.
